ORDER REQUIRING PRO SE PLAINTIFF TO COMPLY WITH LOCAL RULES

On August 9, 2012, the above-styled and -numbered cause was transferred to the Northern District of Texas, Fort Worth division, and randomly assigned to the "Y" docket. Local Civil Rule 5.1(f) requires the parties to register as an electronic case ("ECF") filer.¹

Accordingly, **Mary Cummins** must comply with this local rule no later than 4:00 p.m. on **September 7, 2012**, and shall electronically file a notice of compliance with each of the requirements of this order.² If **Cummins** is unable to file electronically, she may manually file a motion for exemption from the ECF requirements for the Court's consideration.³

Further, **Cummins** shall go to the Court's website and download a copy of the Local Civil Rules for the NDTX⁴ and a copy of the Judge Specific Requirements for this Court, or obtain them from the clerk's office.
