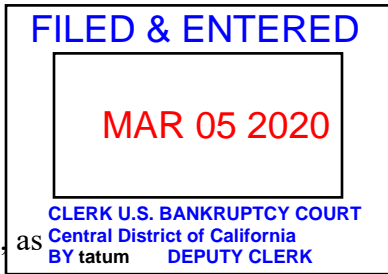

23 As set forth in the Court's Statement of Uncontroverted Facts and Conclusions of Law, [Dkt
24 118] no material issues of fact remain for trial on the Fourth Cause of Action to determine the
25 nondischargeability of the debt owed by Defendant on Plaintiff's judgment and on February 10,

1 2020, this Court entered an Order Denying Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment and entering
2 partial summary judgment on Plaintiff's Fourth Cause of Action to Determine the Non-
3 dischargeability of debts pursuant to 11 USC § 523(a)(6). [Dkt. 117]. Accordingly, Final Judgment
4 is entered on Plaintiff's Fourth Cause of Action in favor of Plaintiff Konstantin Khionidi, as Trustee
5 of the Cobbs Trust, as the prevailing party. The Texas judgment filed in *Bat World Sanctuary et al.*
6 *v. Cummins*, Texas District Court for Tarrant County, Case No. Case No. 352-248169-10 and the
7 Sister-State Judgment entered in *Lollar v. Cummins*, Los Angeles Superior Court Case No
8 BS140207, which judgment was entered as a California Judgment on November 9, 2012 in the
9 amount of \$6,121,039.42 together with interest accruing and costs are hereby determined to be
10 nondischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(6) and judgment is entered accordingly.

12 Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b), made applicable by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7054(a), the court
13 directs entry of a final judgment as to Plaintiff's Fourth Cause of Action under 11 U.S.C. §
14 523(a)(6).
