**Proceedings: [In Chambers] ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY APPEAL  
SHOULD NOT BE DISMISSED**

Appellant Mary Katherine Cobb-Cummins (“Appellant”) initiated this bankruptcy appeal by filing a Notice of Appeal on March 5, 2020. On April 2, 2020, the Bankruptcy Court issued a Deficiency Notice (Dkt. No. 7) indicating that Appellant has not filed a Statement of Issues, Designation of Record, or Notice of Transcript as required by Fed. R. Bankr. Proc. (“FRBP”) 8003 and 8009.

The Court therefore **ORDERS** Appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for failure of comply with the FRBP and for failure to prosecute. The Court may consider Appellant’s filing of the required items along with a declaration of good cause for the delay a sufficient response to this order to show cause. **Appellant must respond no later than April 23, 2020, or the appeal may be dismissed without further notice.**
