3 Stillman's further supplemental declaration, Dkt. No. 185; the oral and written testimony
4 of the parties and the oral and written arguments of the parties, for the reasons stated
5 on the record during the Hearing, the court denies Defendant's Motion for Contempt,
6 Dkt. No. 169.
